Sutton Hoo is the site of Anglo - Saxon cemeteries and burial mounds dating back to the 6th and 7th Centuries, near Woodbridge, Suffolk. Archaeologists have been excavating the area since 1938, when the previously undisturbed ship burial mound, containing a wealth of Anglo-Saxon artefacts, was discovered. If you join the experienced guide, you will travel back in time learning about the history of the beautiful landscape and discover details about the extraordinary 1930s excavations that took place on the brink of war, along with the people involved.

Information and Display exhibitions take place in the NT visitor centre and in Tranmer House (ground floor only). Shop and Cafe are available for indoor/outdoor refreshments.
